



Hockridge flies on Ravens Rock Rally

Welshman Andrew Hockridge enjoyed a strong run on last weekends Carrick on Suir based Ravens Rock Rally in Southern Ireland, hustling his Signature Cheese backed Citroen C2R2Max around the closed public roads to finish twelfth overall and second in class.

Co-driven by fellow Pwllheli resident Darren Garrod, Andrew, who is contesting the C2R2cup for the second year in a row, was using the non championship round to fine tune his pacenotes. The pair were pleased to have been on the pace of championship rival Martin McCormack, trading times throughout the nine stage event last Sunday.

"I came over to Ravens Rock purely to work on writing my own pacenotes but found that I had so much more confidence in them that we've closed the pace to Marty's, which is brilliant! I had a couple of incidents today, including a fourth gear moment when the car stepped out approaching a square right and we had to go straight on down the escape road! I feel that there is a lot more to come from both the car and myself and I'm really looking forward to heading to the Isle of Man in a fortnights time!"

Andrew will be reunited with regular co-driver Rich Mills when the pair resume their championship battle on the fourth round of the 2009 MSA British Rally Championship, the Isle of Man International Rally. Based in Douglas, this two day event begins on Friday 10th July.
